## ACGME Program Requirements for Graduate Medical Education in Complex General Surgical Oncology Summary and Impact of Focused Requirement Revisions

Requirement #: II.B.3.a)

Requirement Revision (significant change only):

Surgical faculty members must have successfully completed a surgical oncology program, spensored by the Society of Surgical Oncology or a complex general surgical oncology program accredited by the ACGME or possess other qualifications found acceptable to the Review Committee. (Core)

- Describe the Review Committee's rationale for this revision: The proposed revision will allow other appropriately-trained physicians to serve as faculty members in ACGMEaccredited programs. Additionally, the osteopathic community has a certification in surgical oncology, and the proposed revision will ensure eligibility of faculty members with that certification.
