



Why did the ACGME establish the David C. Leach Award?

In honor of the former Executive Director of the ACGME (1997-2007), David C. Leach, MD, and his contributions to resident/fellow education and well-being, the ACGME created this award in 2008, with the first recipients awarded in 2010. This award is unique in that it acknowledges and honors residents, fellows, and resident/fellow teams and their contributions to graduate medical education.

Who is eligible?

- Residents or fellows who are *currently* in an educational program (residency or fellowship) (current as identified by the ACGME and its Review Committees in its official roster of residents/fellows)
 - Note: The project leader **must be** a current resident/fellow (at the time of nomination submission) at the program where the project was performed
- Faculty members with residents or fellows
- Multidisciplinary teams (that include faculty members, residents/fellows, allied health professionals, and others) that feature resident/fellow involvement

Note: Back to Bedside grant recipients are not eligible to receive the David C. Leach Award.

Who may nominate?

- Program directors
- Designated institutional officials (DIOs)
- Review Committee members
- Program coordinators

How do I make a nomination?

Download the nomination form from the ACGME website, complete it, and submit it along with three **signed** support letters according to the directions on the form. All materials (nomination form and support letters) must arrive by email in **one** PDF (portable PDF files are <u>NOT</u> acceptable). To do this, assemble all materials and scan. The resulting PDF can then be emailed. **Material received in piecemeal or that includes unsigned letters will not be accepted**. What is the deadline for nominations?

The deadline is **Wednesday, April 6, 2022** and all nominations must be received **by 5:00 p.m. Central**. Nominations received after that date/time will not be accepted.

How many nominees receive the award?

Up to five residents/fellows or teams will be selected.

What is awarded?

A \$2,500 cash award and a plaque.

- If a team wins, the team members will share the cash award and the team will receive one plaque. Only the project leader (*must be a resident or fellow*) and one guest will travel courtesy of the ACGME to the 2023 ACGME Annual Educational Conference.
- An individual winner will receive the entire cash award and plaque, and the awardee and a guest will travel courtesy of the ACGME to the 2023 Annual Educational Conference.

When will the award winners be announced?

Selections will be made by the ACGME Awards Committee at its fall 2022 meeting; afterwards, ACGME President and CEO Dr. Thomas J. Nasca will notify recipients. The recipients will be acknowledged at the 2023 ACGME Annual Educational Conference. Award announcements will be published in a press release, the *Journal of Graduate Medical Education*, and the ACGME *e-Communication*, as well as on the ACGME website and social media accounts.
