Lynne E. Meyer, PhD, MPH, joined the ACGME in 2008. She is the executive director for the Review Committees for Diagnostic Radiology, Emergency Medicine, , and Nuclear Medicine, and has previously served as executive director for the Review Committees for Family Medicine, Neurology and Psychiatry. Dr. Meyer was the assistant dean for medical education and evaluation at the University of Illinois College of Medicine at Peoria's Division of Educational Services (DES) from 2004-2007, after serving as interim assistant dean for seven months prior. Before then she served the same division as coordinator of faculty development for measurement and evaluation for eight years. Other positions include: curriculum coordinator for the residency program in family practice at Methodist Medical Center of Illinois

through the University of Illinois College of Medicine at Peoria; research assistant at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign's Office of Continuing Education; dental hygienist; residency curriculum coordinator for the Department of Family Practice at Southern Illinois University School of Medicine; visiting specialist in health occupations education for the Vocational Education Service at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign's College of Agriculture; research assistant for the Department of Vocational and Technical Education at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign's College of Education; and dental assisting instructor for the Life Science Division of Parkland Community College. Dr. Meyer is an administrative advisor to the Council of Review Committees' Standardization Subcommittee, and a member of the Department of Accreditation Committees (DAC) Data Analysis, Case Log Reporting Focus Group.
