Patricia B. Levenberg, PhD, joined the ACGME in 2001. She is the executive director for the Review Committees for Obstetrics and Gynecology, Ophthalmology, and Ophthalmology, and has previously served as executive director for the Review Committees for Allergy and Immunology, Dermatology, Otolaryngology, and Preventive Medicine. Prior to her tenure at the ACGME, she was a university professor of nursing at Governor's State University; an assistant professor of nursing at Rush University College of Nursing; a pediatric nurse practitioner with the University of Chicago's Child Life Center; director of Well Child Care with the Cook County Health Department's Park Forest office; project director for the American Medical Association's (AMA) Department of Adolescent Health; senior policy analyst

for federation relations with the AMA; and director of program development and professional affairs with the Society of Critical Care Medicine. Dr. Levenberg served as an ACGME liaison to the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada from 2006-2010, and was a Department of Accreditation Committees (DAC) representative to the ACGME Data Access, Use, and Research Committee. She is an administrative advisor for the ACGME Council of Review Committees' Hospital-Based Ancillary Services Section and a member of the DAC Staff Development Focus Group and IRC/RRC Member Appointments Focus Group. She assisted with the development of a resource handbook for ex-officio members of ACGME Review Committees and is a participant in the ACGME Awards Committee selection process. Recognitions and honoraria include: Sigma Theta Tau Nursing Honorary designation; recipient of the National Association of Nurse Practitioner Faculties Research Award; recipient of the University of Illinois College of Nursing Irving Harris Visiting Scholar Award; recipient of the March of Dimes "March On" volunteer award.
