### A. Resident Evaluation

#### 2. Summative Evaluation

#### Common Program Requirement:

2. *Summative Evaluation*

*The program director must provide a summative evaluation for each resident upon completion of the program. This evaluation must become part of the resident's permanent record maintained by the institution, and must be accessible for review by the resident in accordance with institutional policy. This evaluation must:*

- a) document the resident's performance during the final period of education, and*
- b) verify that the resident has demonstrated sufficient competence to enter practice without direct supervision.*

- **Documentation for summative evaluation:** Among the documents that must be available for the site visitor are copies of the summative evaluations for the most recent year's graduates. Site visitors will review these evaluations to determine if the program is in compliance with the requirements. In addition, site visitors will interview residents to verify resident survey responses concerning availability of current and previous evaluations. (See survey question below.)

#### Resident Survey Question:

*12. Are you able to review your current and previous performance evaluations upon request?*
