From the Program Setup menu, under the Rotation section click on the **Add/Update** link.

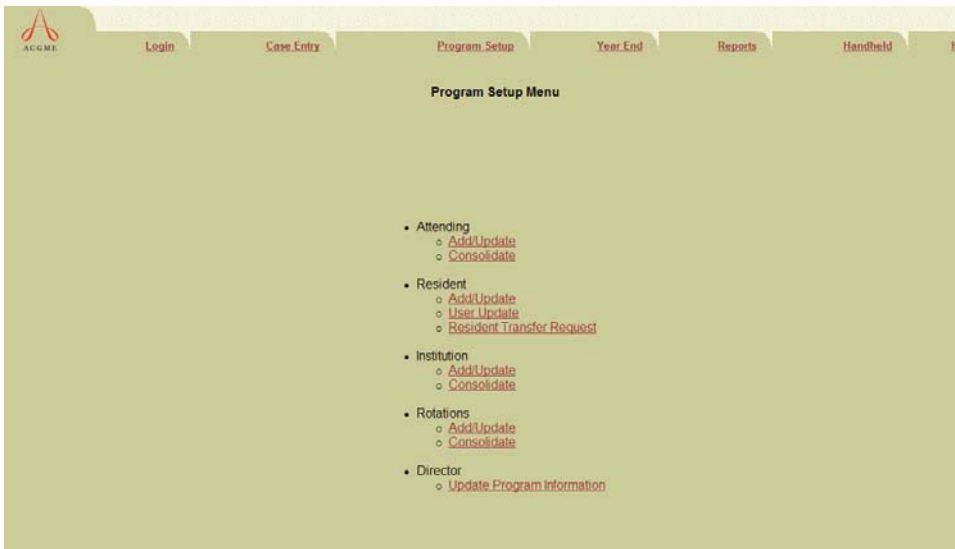


Figure 1: Program Setup

If there is a rotation that is not included, click on **Add Rotation**.




Figure 2: Add/Update


