<sup>\*</sup>Role(s): Surgeon + Observe – indicates that a resident can receive credit in this category minimum by *either* performing *or* observing.

Please note that the "Numbers Performed" column of the Minimums Report reflects "Surgeon + Observed" for all but Excisions and Repairs (Surgeon only).

<sup>\*\*</sup>Only one nail procedure performed on a human cadaver hand or foot can count toward satisfying this requirement. The Review Committee does not discourage the use of such simulation models when residents are first learning procedural techniques, but the Committee also recognizes there are limitations to cadaver-based procedures, including clinical assessment of adequate anesthesia and management of hemostasis. Thus, programs that utilize human cadavers to meet minimum nail procedure requirements should continue to pursue experiences on live humans as an area for program improvement.
