Programs, in partnership with their Sponsoring Institutions, will determine how compliance with the requirements is achieved.

Therefore, the Review Committee expects that the majority of the core faculty will be ABIM- or AOBIM- certified. However, critical care medicine physicians with certification from the American Board of Emergency Medicine can also be identified as core subspecialty faculty members as long as they have completed a 24-month critical care medicine fellowship in an ACGME-accredited internal medicine critical care medicine program. In addition, although anesthesia and surgical critical care medicine physicians can also participate in the program, they cannot be counted towards the minimum required number of subspecialtycertified core faculty members. 2.10.c.
