RE: Call for Resident Member of the Review Committee for Surgery

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The Review Committee is soliciting nominations for its next resident member for a term that will run July 1, 2027 to June 30, 2029.

**Qualifications of the Resident Member**

- Nominees must be in good standing and actively enrolled in a residency or fellowship program at the time of appointment and may not serve more than one year beyond completion of residency or fellowship.
- Nominees enrolled in a general surgery or integrated vascular surgery program must be, at a minimum, in the second year of residency at the time of nomination.
- Nominees in a fellowship program must be in their first year of the program at the time of nomination.

The resident member may not serve on two Review Committees simultaneously. The Review Committee seeks heterogeneous geographic representation and may only have up to two members from the same state. As such, the Review Committee will be unable to accept nominees located in California or Ohio. As of July 1, 2027, the Review Committee composition will be as follows:

**Responsibilities of the Resident Member**

The resident member participates as a full voting member in all Review Committee activities, including program review and policy discussion. The resident member must attend all Review Committee meetings. The committee meets three times per year, in person, in Chicago, Illinois. The resident member is subject to compliance with the

same confidentiality, conflict of interest, duality of interest, and fiduciary responsibility policies as the other members. The resident member must be able to devote approximately 30 hours to program review prior to each Review Committee meeting.

The resident member is also a member of the ACGME Council of Review Committee Residents (CRCR). The CRCR is composed of the resident member from each Review and Recognition Committee and is an important part of the ACGME because it provides valuable input and feedback to the ACGME Board of Directors about matters related to residents and fellows, graduate medical education, and accreditation from the resident/fellow perspective. The CRCR meets twice a year, typically in person.

*Note: It is the program director's responsibility to ensure that the resident member will have sufficient time to review programs, attend Review Committee and CRCR meetings in person, and participate in activities of the Review Committee and the ACGME. While this nomination is for a term that officially begins July 1, 2027, note that the resident/fellow will be required to attend activities six months prior to the official start date, including a formal orientation meeting and two observational Review Committee meetings.*

### **To Submit a Nomination**

Submit the following documents electronically:

- A completed nomination form (interested individuals should email Aimee Morales ([amorales@acgme.org](mailto:amorales@acgme.org)) for the form).
- Letter of interest from the resident/fellow which includes a personal statement outlining educational goals, professional interests, and intent to serve, if selected.
- The resident's/fellow's curriculum vitae.
- Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from the nominee's program director and must include assurance that the nominee will have sufficient time to review programs, attend in-person Review Committee and CRCR meetings, and participate in activities of the Review Committee and the ACGME as expected.

Send completed nominations to Associate Executive Director Aimee Morales at [amorales@acgme.org](mailto:amorales@acgme.org) by **August 21, 2026**. A member of the Review Committee staff will confirm that the nomination has been received.

The Review Committee will review the nominations and forward its selection to the ACGME Board of Directors for approval at its September 2026 meeting.

Nominees will be notified of the Review Committee's selection by email after confirmation by the ACGME Board of Directors.

### **Additional Information**

Review Committee members must use electronic systems for reimbursement of expenses and accreditation activities (e.g., program reviews). The resident member will be required to travel three times per year to meet as a member of the Review Committee. Review Committee meetings are two-day meetings. All related travel and meeting expenses are covered by the ACGME.
